In video surveillance, objects of varying sizes need to be detected, recognized or identified. Legacy video surveillance specifications call out resolution and focal length but leave out the important component of visual acuity. The Gish Index of visual acuity allows the video surveillance professional to specify with confidence and guarantee performance before a single camera is installed.
